**50+ HOUSING COUNCIL** — Affiliated with the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) 50+ Council, is the voice of the 50+ housing industry and a leading source of information and research on the active adult and independent living communities.

The Baby Boomer generation, those born between 1946 and 1964, is transitioning into retirement, reaching 100 million by 2012.
